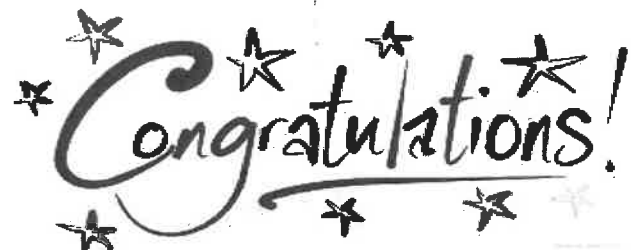
What is PBIS?
